Things to note:

- Auditions are open and free to anyone in our community ages 5-15 years old.
- Pricing for participation in our Covid Nutcracker 2020 is TBD but will include the cost of costuming, one digital copy of the performance, and two tickets to a catered live show and screening.
- Our guided audition video focuses on a few basic ballet skills. If you have other
 performance skills or talents, please include them after you have demonstrated the
 dance portion of the audition in your video. Additionally, some skills may be beyond
 your dancer (5 year olds are not expected to perform pirouettes!). Please only do what
 they feel comfortable performing.

The commitment - once auditions have been submitted and casting has been sent out, we'll ask you to commit to the following dates and rehearsals:

October 10-November 7 will include at home rehearsal using a pre-recorded video

- November 7th and 8th (time TBD) in-person (masked, social distanced) at Durango Dance or zoom rehearsals for those who feel more comfortable
- November 14th and 15th (time TBD) in-person (masked, social distanced) at Durango Dance or zoom rehearsals for those who feel more comfortable
- November 21st (time TBD) performances filmed in-person, individually at Durango Dance
- December 5th and 6th Performance Showing

I am so thrilled to extend this invitation to the community, and look forward to watching all of the auditions that come our way. These auditions will not determine whether a child can participate. Rather, they will determine which number the dancer will perform in. We welcome all dancers of our community!
